The Court Jester

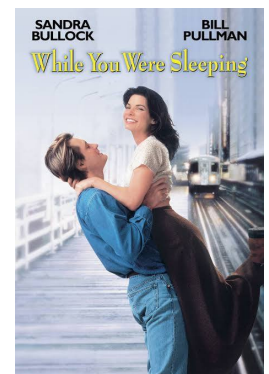
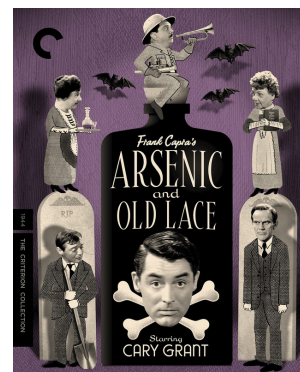

MEMORY CAFÉS

What is a memory café?

Memory Cafés are a comfortable, social gathering in dementia friendly venues that allow people experiencing memory loss and a loved one to connect, socialize, and build new support networks. Cafés are free and all are welcome.

What a memory café is NOT?

- NOT a workshop, seminar or lecture about dementia.
 - NOT a facilitated support group. (Although the Café is a supportive environment.)
 - NOT a drop-off respite program. (It's a place for partners to interact with each other in new ways.)

When: 2-4 pm on the third Wednesday of every month, and an in-between Tuesday during the month.

Where: First UU Congregation of Ann Arbor, 4001 Ann Arbor Saline Rd, Ann Arbor

Entertainment: Cafes typically feature entertainment, such as professional musicians, magicians, or food preparation demonstrations, along with active engagement, such as chair exercise, collaborative storytelling, laughing yoga, drum circles—and much more. There's always coffee, tea and light snacks, often provided by a local senior care provider or facility

Also at the Café: There are tables full of free, evidence-based literature about dementia, brain changes and caregiving, from reliable sources. There's also literature from a wide array of local service providers and residential facilities.
